Prior to co-founding Draper Fisher Jurvetson Gotham Ventures, Mr. Goldstein was Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer of Interactive Imaginations, Inc., one of the East Coast's pioneering Internet companies, and the predecessor company to 24/7 Real Media, Inc., which was recently acquired by WPP Group. Prior to Interactive Imaginations, Mr. Goldstein was with Morgan Stanley for 13 years, where he had most recently been a senior banker responsible for equity financings for the firm's technology, telecommunications and media clients. He also serves on the Board of Directors of New York Cares, a non-profit volunteer organization based in New York City. Mr. Goldstein received a B.S. in Applied Mathematics-Economics, *magna cum laude*, from Brown University and an M.B.A. from the Stanford University Graduate School of Business.
